LIFE VERSES: GOD'S PLANS

Years ago, I belonged to a Presbyterian Women's circle: young women who enjoyed studying scripture together. During those years many babies were born, mothers brought them to our meetings. We took turns holding them. Soon toddlers were running around providing laughter as we studied. Older women shook their heads, wondering how we could study with noisy children, but we did. One night we read Matthew 4:23-24 (above). Only later I would understand its importance on my life.

In my forties I felt a need to go back to school because my work for an international company wasn't fulfilling. People told me I was too old to go back to college, but I did it anyway. After receiving a 4-year degree, I began seminary, continuing to work full time. It was a challenge, along with the hour and fifteen-minute commute, but I did it. After thirteen years of study, two masters' degrees, more seminary study, and a year of hospital chaplain training, finally, I was ordained and became pastor for an intercity church.

What is the scripture verse that shares the plan God has for you? It may change over time, but you are never too young or too old for God to have a plan for your life.
